#### **About Ken Sanders:**

Ken Sanders is a rare books collector in Salt Lake City, Utah. He co-owned The Cosmic Aeroplane from 1975 to 1981, founded Dream Garden Press in 1980, and founded Ken Sanders Rare Books in 1990. He has hosted book signings and art exhibitions. He is a member of the Antiquarian Bookseller's Association of America and specializes in Western and Native Americana, Utah and Mormons, Modern First Editions, and Prints. Ken Sanders is also the subject of *The Man Who Loved Books Too Much* by Allison Hoover Bartlett, concerning Sanders' role in capturing book thief John Charles Gilkey.

#### About the Ken Sanders Collection:

This material was collected over time by Ken Sanders before being purchased by the Museum. Some material may come from the Thomas F. Hansen family. The material covers Park City's history from as early as 1878. Included are papers from the Park Utah Consolidated Mine, records related to other mines in the area, and records from Park City and Summit County.
